2. All Achieving Lives trainers maintain a state where they welcome any challenge to their conduct. Achieving Lives trainers take full responsibility for the behaviour and language they produce.
3. Achieving Lives is an equal opportunities trainer and will seek to train individuals and organisations from all groups fairly and without discrimination.
4. NLP trainers will ensure they understand the parameters of their training ability and will not seek to provide "expert" advice in areas where they are not professionally trained.
5. Achieving Lives as a training organisation itself operates according to a model which is subject to improvement as it interacts with it's clients.
6. Achieving Lives will communicate and behave according to the values expressed in the public domain on the Achieving Lives web site.
7. Achieving Lives trainers commit to annual personal professional development to ensure their skills are up to date.
8. Achieving Lives trainers endeavour to live their personal and organisational lives according to the pre-suppositions of NLP which they believe to be useful.
